### 3. The Huma Kabakci Collection (max. 250 words):

The residency is an opportunity to develop a project in dialogue with the Huma Kabakci Collection. Explain your interest in this element of the residency. How might the collection inform your final project proposal in a creative way?

### 4. Professional development (max. 300 words):
